RECONSIDERATION - City of Thousand Oaks Reorganization – Rancho Potrero Specific Plan

- LAFCo 10-06A City of Thousand Oaks Area of Interest Amendment
- LAFCo 10-06S1 City of Thousand Oaks Sphere of Influence Amendment
- LAFCo 10-06S2 Conejo Recreation and Park District Sphere of Influence Amendment
- LAFCo 10-06 City of Thousand Oaks Reorganization (Annexation to the City of Thousand Oaks, Annexation to the Conejo Recreation and Park District and detachment from the Ventura County Resource Conservation District and County Service Area No. 32.

The City of Thousand Oaks has submitted a request consisting of three components. First, the City requests that the original reorganization proposal, sphere of influence amendments and area of interest amendment be re-heard in lieu of reconsideration. In conjunction with their request for a re-hearing, the City is requesting a waiver of their \$3,100 filing fee. Should the request for a re-hearing not be approved, the second request seeks approval of a request for reconsideration subject to Government Code Section 56895. Should both the request for a re-hearing and the request for reconsideration not be approved, the City's third request is for the Commission to waive the one-year time limit on filing a similar proposal pursuant to Government Code Section 56884(b).
