RESOLUTION OF THE VENTURA LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION MAKING DETERMINATIONS AND APPROVING THE PROPOSAL FROM VENTURA COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 4 TO EXERCISE A LATENT POWER TO PROVIDE VOLUNTEERS-IN-POLICING SERVICE

WHEREAS, the above-referenced proposal has been filed with the Executive Officer of the Ventura Local Agency Formation Commission ("LAFCo" or "Commission") pursuant to the Cortese-Knox-Hertzberg Local Government Reorganization Act of 2000 (§ 56000 et seq. of the California Government Code) and the County Service Area Law (§ 25210 et seq. of the Government Code); and

WHEREAS, notice was provided at the times and in the manner required by law; and

WHEREAS, the proposal was duly considered on May 16, 2018, as specified in the notice of hearing; and

WHEREAS, evidence has been provided to the Commission that the affected territory contains more than 12 registered voters and is therefore inhabited as defined by Government Code § 56046; and

WHEREAS, the Commission heard, discussed and considered all oral and written testimony for and against the proposal including, but not limited to, the LAFCo Staff Report (which contains the recommendations and a discussion of applicable spheres of influence and local plans and policies); and

WHEREAS, the Commission finds the proposal to be in the best interest of the landowners and present and future inhabitants of the affected territory, and the organization of local governmental agencies within Ventura County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Commission as follows:

(1) The LAFCo Staff Report dated May 16, 2018, and recommendation for approval of the proposal are adopted; and

- The subject proposal is assigned the following distinctive short form designation:
  VENTURA COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 4 ACTIVATION OF LATENT POWER FOR
  VOLUNTEERS-IN-POLICING SERVICE; and
- (3) The proposal is exempt from CEQA pursuant to § 15061(b)(3) of the CEQA Guidelines and LAFCo staff is directed to file a Notice of Exemption under § 15062 of the CEQA Guidelines; and
- (4) Ventura County Service Area No. 4 will have sufficient revenues to carry out the proposed new volunteers-in-policing service; and
- (5) The change of organization to exercise a latent power to provide volunteers-in-policing service is hereby approved, and the boundaries for such service are established as generally set forth in the attached Exhibit A; and
- (6) The change of organization is subject to conducting authority proceedings, pursuant to Government Code § 57000 et seq.; and
- (7) The Certificate of Completion for the subject change of organization shall not be recorded until all LAFCo fees have been paid.
