VENTURA LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION

Notice is hereby given that the Alternate Public Member seat of the Ventura Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCo) is vacant. The unexpired term of office ends on January 1, 2017.

LAFCo is a regulatory agency established by state law to review proposals for boundary changes for local governments, to establish spheres of influence for cities and special districts within Ventura County, and to conduct service reviews to promote the efficiency and effectiveness of service delivery.

The Commission is composed of two members of the Ventura County Board of Supervisors, two city council members, two independent special district board members, and a public member who is selected by the other six commissioners. Alternate members are also selected for each membership category.

State law prohibits any officer or employee of Ventura County, or any city or special district within this County, from serving as the Alternate Public Member. The only other requirements for this position are residency within Ventura County, the ability to attend monthly meetings held on weekday mornings, and an interest in the operation and organization of local governments.
